## ISCO acquires Industrial Underground in Houston

**(Louisville)** March 7, 2007 – ISCO Industries, the nation's largest distributor and supplier of polyethylene (HDPE) piping products, has announced the acquisition of Industrial Underground Company in Houston, Texas.

Industrial Underground was a partnership between Scott Lindsay and Fraser Mining and Industrial Supply, a company in Mansfield, Texas acquired by ISCO on March 5, 2007. Industrial Underground became part of that purchase agreement between Fraser and ISCO.

"Getting Industrial Underground as part of the Fraser negotiations was critical as part of the deal. This is a company with an excellent reputation in Houston's petrochemical, refinery and power plant construction markets," said Jimmy Kirchdorfer, President of ISCO Industries. "The technical expertise that ISCO brings to the table is second to none," said Lindsay. "Their leadership in the HDPE piping industry will allow us to better serve our customers throughout the region. I'm very excited to be part of the team," he said.

This acquisition continues ISCO's fast track expansion that has seen the opening of facilities in Virginia and Georgia this year, and in Alberta, Canada and Nebraska, Maryland and California in 2006 – in addition to the opening of an expansive new fabrication and storage facility in Louisville, Kentucky.

ISCO Industries, headquartered in Louisville, Kentucky, stocks and sells HDPE pipe, fittings and fabrications for various industrial, municipal, environmental, golf and landfill applications throughout the United States and Canada. The company also rents, services and sells fusion equipment. ISCO has stocking locations in the states of Maryland, Colorado, Connecticut, Washington, Michigan, Alabama, Florida, Kentucky, South Carolina, Oklahoma, Texas, Wisconsin, Utah, Arizona, Nebraska, Illinois, California, Virginia, Georgia and Alberta, Canada – inventorying large stockpiles of pipe, usually within one day's delivery of most projects.
